Dear Parents/Guardians,

Please be advised that your son is incomplete (INC) in one or more courses. It is his responsibility to contact the applicable teacher(s) to identify outstanding work and submit the work to his teacher(s) no later than **12:00 p.m. on Friday, June 20th**; the final deadline for clearing incomplete work.

It is recommended that your son arrange to be at school during the exam period to complete his outstanding work when he is not scheduled to write his exams. It is your son's responsibility to contact his teacher(s) and counsellor if he needs guidance in completing unfinished coursework.

A student marked incomplete in a course, must still write the exam as per the exam schedule. He must clear the incomplete and attain a passing final mark to obtain course credit.

Submitted work must meet a passing standard to clear the incomplete. Sub-standard work, submissions after the final deadline, or a final course mark below 50% will result in a failure in the applicable course(s).
