### Protocol for Home Game Spectators St. Paul's High School

#### Effective Date – October 20, 2021

This protocol will be reviewed on an ongoing basis in accordance with public health orders.

#### Indoor Games

<u>Only parents/guardians/family members of St. Paul's High School team participants</u> involved in competition will be permitted as spectators.

- A limit of two spectators per participant is strongly recommended.
- Family members under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- Spectators will be admitted approximately 10 minutes prior to game time.

Spectators require proof of immunization and matching photo ID to enter.

Children aged 11 and under are able to attend with an adult that has presented valid proof of immunization that matches their photo ID. Children aged 11 and under are not required to provide photo ID. Children aged 12 and older are required to present valid proof of immunization as indicated above. Photo ID is encouraged but is not required.

School officials, or a volunteer appointed by school administration, will scan the QR code, or verify valid proof of immunization and will only allow entry following a valid result that matches the photo ID provided.

## St. Paul's High School reserves the right to restrict entry based on site capacity as determined through consultation with public health officials.

#### Additional Protocols for Indoor Games

- a) Complete the <u>MB COVID-19 Screening Tool</u> before attending.
- b) Masks must be worn at all times while in the school.
- c) Separate access will be required depending on the game location.
  - **Cass Gym**: Parking is available in the Student Lot off Bower Blvd. Use the Student Entrance and proceed to the Cass Gym.
  - **Richardson Gym (MultiPlex)**: Parking is available in the Lot off Holland Blvd. Use the Main Entrance of the MultiPlex.
- d) All spectators are to sit in the bleachers, in household groupings, physically distanced 2 metres or more, from other household groupings.
- e) Please leave the gym as soon as the game ends.
- f) Gatherings are not permitted in the stands or on the court following games.
- g) Spectators may leave and return to the site, however, proof of immunization and matching photoID must be presented to a school official in order to re-enter the site.

- a) Complete the <u>MB COVID-19 Screening Tool</u> before attending.
- b) Parking is available in the Student Lot off Bower Blvd. Field access is available through the gates on the South end of the Student Lot.
- c) All spectators are to sit in the bleachers or available picnic tables along the West sideline, in household groupings, physically distanced 2 metres or more, from other household groupings.
- d) There is to be no wandering the sidelines.
- e) Masks must be worn when entering the school to access the washroom facilities located near the entrance of Murray Hall.
- f) Please leave the field as soon as the game ends.
- g) Gatherings are not permitted in the stands or on the field following games.
- h) Pets are not permitted on the school grounds.
- Spectators may leave and return to the site, however, proof of immunization and matching photo
  ID must be presented to a school official in order to re-enter the site.
